Together with our Kentucky co-counsel, former Kentucky lawyer of the suit last week against Shire USA, Inc. seeking actual and punitive damages for the tragic, wrongful, and unnecessary death of a **second innocent child**. The case, styled as *Branson v. Shire USA, Inc.* is posted on our website, www.justiceseekers.com. The basis for claiming punitive damages includes the following:

Shire had 141 days from the time its Vice President Antonsson admitted Adderall's role in Tyra Ehlis's death until the day that Nathaniel Branson died. Based on its first quarter sales figures for year 2000, it was garnering approximately \$597,260 in gross revenues from Adderall sales on each of those days. Thus, while it consciously disregarded the dangers to Dawn Marie Branson and Nathaniel Branson, it reaped the benefit from approximately \$84,213,699 in Adderall revenues. The Kentucky state court suit recently filed by our firm seeks actual and punitive damages in light of these facts.
