ORDER


Appellant has filed a motion requesting this Court summarily reverse his conviction. The State has requested an extension of time in which to file its return.

Appellant's motion is denied. Accordingly, the State's request for an extension of time to respond to the motion is moot.

Appellant has also requested that his appeal be expedited. We grant the motion to expedite and direct that Appellant serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days from the date of this order. Within thirty days after service of Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter, the State shall serve and file its initial brief and designation of matter. Appellant shall have ten days to serve any reply brief. Appellant shall serve

and file the record on appeal within fifteen days after service of the last brief.
Each party shall serve and file their final briefs within ten days after service
of the record on appeal.
